



Ok, back to the Throne seat base. The first thing to do is pull the 4 black plastic inserts at the bottom of the leg braces (Pg 10 pic 2A). They may be pulled out with your fingers, if stuck; leverage a pry-bar or flat screw driver to help. These inserts prevent damage from the steel to the carrying bag. Once out, place the 4 shoe inserts in the colored Deity back-pack, do not lose parts!

Take the legs out of their socks and place them in the square tubing of the Throne Base with the 1/4" holes lined behind holes in the sleeves (keep the oval hole at the top). Insert the 3/16" pins in the middle holes at the leg & tube underneath (Pg 10 pic 3a). Place emptied socks in the carrying bag, and remember, don't lose parts or paddings, use the pack for intermediate part storage, use the yellow carry bags for larger packing materials.

Place the Throne seat up on its leg's now, the two back braces will need to be inserted on the top of the back leg sleeves just above the Deity base shoe (Pg 10 pic 4a). First slide the brace studs into the top back openings of the seat. All felt cloth and knob bolts should be facing forward. (*Subhadra's Throne back brace has a different fastener placement than the other two, regardless all threading is the same*). Once the studs are loosely in the chair bottom, tilt the Throne back to access the mid-section of the leg sleeve underneath. Take the 1/8" pins and lock in place at the upper hole in the square tubing underneath the seat (Pg 10 pic 5A). This will take a bit of FF shifting and wiggling to get the pin fully inserted. Now all braces & legs should be mounted to the seat, Continue (OOPS)

Now it's time to thread the brace knob bolts to the tapped opening at the top of the chair seat, (Pg 10 pic 4A). Once the braces are partially (FF) threaded in place, carefully open the backboard bag (Pg 12 pic 6B) and pull out the specific Throne seat backing from the cardboard. Place BB loosely installing vertical bolts to the back braces; note color coded felt, (Pg 12 pic 5B)

Once all fasteners are installed, tighten till snug and the 1/8" pins are in we will deliver the completed thrones and their bases to their selective chariot.

Now working with the Chariots crew, we measure & mount the bottom sleeve boards to front center position of the Chariot front stage floor (Pg 12 pic 4B). Exact face position will be designated as to where the backboard will fit at the front canopy rails. Use the same 1/8" pins to secure the Thrones to the floor braces. Then add the accessories: seat belts (note; buckle is fed though the back), skirting and padding (Pg 12 4B). When the assemblies are complete the next operation is getting the Thrones to Their chariots. Lord Jaganatha 1<sup>st</sup> Ratyha, Lady Subhadra 2<sup>Nd</sup> and Baladeva on 3<sup>rd</sup>. Srila Prabhupada's small throne is next to Subhadra's Throne on Her front right side. All Thrones assemble the same way; we'll reverse order of operations, when we will be breaking down.
