## “Done -Deal”

You need to read this NOW... the end brings us to the beginning, do we have your attention?

These are the final instructions in our SFRY Handbook, and as with good instructions they may be used anytime when needed.

After all is finished, overlook your “Ksetra-Jnana” (Field of Activities). Are all the tools and materials are properly packed? The truck is secure & loaded? We’ve left the park clean... then we’re ready to return the Temples equipment and paraphernalia. If we’ve done our job, everything will be ready for others to continue with our next festival. In doing our post-operative checks we insure an easier set-up for whoever is on the next event.

Where ever a Vaishnava goes, they achieve goals, although, they may not always show, regardless, don’t our let our ego’s stifle the flow, results are how we know. Stay focused on Seva action (service) and time will bring needed satisfaction.

Now, the sad thing is that we may have incongruities of Sadhana from when we were working. Keep track of our missed japa and resting periods, in the aftermath we can seek retribution. These special events are in the Spiritual realm; still we tread on material events at the same time.

Fortunately, as Maharaja Bhaktisiddhanta Sarasvati Thakur informs us there is some compensation when we are fully dedicated in a service for the Lord. On a morning walk Srila Prabhupada also commented:

“Pañcadraṇḍya: Prabhupada some devotees they do lots of devotional service every day, but we know they are not chanting japa. What can we do?

Prabhupāda: Situation, he is doing some service, He is doing some service?

Pañcadraṇḍya: Yes.

Prabhupāda: So because on account of that service, if he could not, that can be excused, but not that practice should be taken as a permanent business. If you cannot finish then the next day you should forget sleeping and eating, you must finish your rounds.”

If we have some temporary deficiency in our japa, specific seva bestows grace periods that’s allowed in emergencies. Let your Soul comply in Krishna’s service, include your Sadhana, we must chant while we’re working. Do the needful; always fulfill your dharma to your fullest potential. Seva is Eternal.
