PACKING UP

PARKING: The first service will be getting a 25' bobtail truck loaded at the Temple. This vehicle is managed by NJP staff and your arrangements. 2 parking vouchers will be placed on the windshield dash of said vehicle, one permit is for Berkeley street parking, and the other is for San Francisco (SF) event parking. Best to park adjacent to the Temple's front door, loading will soon follow. We use a total of 3 trucks. The *Roadies* truck is for Gaura & Nitai's rolling float, Altar Stages, Chariot Thrones & Altar Thrones, plus the Vyasasana. The other 2 trucks are for the Kitchen & Gift Shop. Majority of all our festival & parade gear is kept in Prasadam Hall (PH) storage. Some lashings and fasteners may be located in outside storage sheds.

SIDE NOTE: *"A place for everything, and everything in its place"(AP4E). Based on past hauls we've established current loading arrangements. Often volunteers who've intended to improve our transports have caused delays. We stick to the current lay-out unless necessity changes it.*

PRIORITIZING ITEMS: There is an organized manner to best set-up this haul out service of Altar, stages, float and accessories (AP4E). The first thing we begin is pulling essential items from the storeroom to the East parameter of the PH. You may find some items already on the PH set-up area. If there are enough volunteers and our Roadie is experienced, some items may be directly loaded, just "KNOW" where they go! (Pg. 6)

It is essential to maintain Temple PR functions. Stacking modular stages, thrones & cases, crates and supply boxes in a safe and unobtrusive manner is important. Adaptations are always a fact, so, do the needful, perceive things before they happen, adjust to others also working in the same area, respectfully direct any who may be in the way of article transport or in danger of tripping or damaging items, including themselves.

There may be other minor items, added later. The main thing is an organized break-down, pack-up and transport to Golden Gate Park.

G & N FLOAT: Another facet of the load job is getting the Gaura-Nitai (G&N) rolling Float and Deities taken down to be loaded. They are in the Temple room adjacent to the PH. Tools and 4 able persons will be needed to pull their Lordships of the float. Lay the provided judo pads and quilts in the central West floor of the PH for G&N.
