



**SIDE NOTE:** All the stage tables have Velcro-tape on the top side edges. Do NOT drag them, they have to be placed. If they're dragged, abrasion will damage the strips and the skirting won't adhere. If low on manpower a piece of tarp or dollie may used underneath to slide or roll them.

**Stage Tables:** There are 5 tables, (2: 6'X4's) (1: 7'x4') (1: 3'x 4') (1: 6' x 16"). Vertically place all of them at the back right side. When assembled at site, they make 3 separate stages. The 2, 6'X4's are first against the wall, side by side length way up. This way the rest of the Tables will hold them in place. Next, stack the 7"x 4" and the 6' x 16" on their side on top of each other against the other 2; 6' pieces. While holding these in place, bring the 3'x4' to the front. 2 cinch lashings around the front of these panels to the wood slats. We need to safely and securely keep them in place.

**SP's Big Throne (Vyasasana):** The Head board to the center Cab wall panel, the seat on its back edge slid against it. Double lash cinches from side wall slats. Vyasasana has its Head board placed on bottom edge to the back cab side of the truck and the seat on edge against the back, place lashing around both pieces snug to the wall.

**Red Upholstered Thrones:** Will go across from the modular stage, all 3 lashed together at the side walls. The 3 yellow bagged thrones, & back-board bag (Pg. 10 6B) will be placed on the right of the Thrones floorboard.

**The following application may vary according to adapting to vehicle dimensions.**

**G&N's Entrance.** We will need 100' of rope weaved to fit 8' "hammocks" from side to side of the Wood side slates (Pg. 7) about 4' high. Use 1 or 2 hammocks; adjust height depending on the vehicle capacity. If hammock is out then plan "B" Lay-out: (Pg. 6), judo mats on the floor from below the float halves. G&N lay head to toe of each other. This gives room for padding and lashing them carefully to prevent them from bumping into One another.

**Float halves** are next. We need at least 3 to 4 men to handle these. Bring 1 half at a time to the trucks hydraulic tail-gate. Bring the float halves one at a time, placed on their backs, with the wheels towards the wall. Keep good reigns on the float as it's raised on the gate to the bed, once up, carefully slide it down with the wheels backs going against the side-walls. Bring the 2<sup>nd</sup> float to the tailgate and repeat. Once both are in Bring the floats as close to the other items stacked in the truck, lash well to the truck wall.
